Sandipan Chattopadhyay was one of the pioneers of the Hungryalism Movement, and among the foremost Bengali fiction writers of modern



times. His first collection of short stories, *Kritadas Kritadasi* (1961), is credited with completely changing the landscape of Bengali fiction. A staunch anti-establishment figure and a supporter of creative freedom, Sandipan's stories reflect his politics and his concerns with class and gender relations. He was awarded the Bankim Puraskar and the Sahitya Akademi Award for his work.

Brilliantly rendered by award-winning translator Arunava Sinha, *Ten Days of the Strike* brings a comprehensive selection of Sandipan Chattopadhyay's work to English readers for the very first time.

SANDIPAN CHATTOPADHYAY (1933–2005) was one of the pioneers of the Hungryalism Movement, and among the most important Bengali fiction writers of modern times. He was awarded the 1995 Bankim Puraskar and the 2002 Sahitya Academy Award for his work.






Late on a Sunday night, Shreya Ved, an investigator probing match-fixing in the Mega Cricket League, is found murdered in her office.







Avinash Shrestha is one of the most important contemporary poets writing in Nepali today. Born in India to Nepali immigrants, Shrestha migrated to Kathmandu in 1984 from Assam to pursue graduate studies. His first book of poetry, published in 1990, created a stir in the poetry scene in Kathmandu. He brought a distinctly Sanskritheavy idiom - that also drew from the Assamese, Urdu, Hindi and Bengali poetry of India - into Nepali poetry which was, at the time, mired in social and moral themes. This new poetry was necessarily syncretic, and surrealist by design. Shrestha's later work intersects his distinct idiom with themes of climate justice, mourning the ecological degradation in the Eastern Himalayas.

This selection from his four books of poetry, as well as some of his new uncollected poems – all translated brilliantly by the award-winning poet Rohan Chhetri – is the first serious book of translation of any contemporary Nepali poetry into English.

Poet, playwright and short-story writer AVINASH SHRESTHA is one of the foremost writers in Nepal. He was an editor for Samakalin Sahitya, a popular literary journal, and Garima, a monthly literary magazine.

**ROHAN CHHETRI** is a writer and translator. He is the author of *Slow Startle*, *Jurassic Desire* and *Lost*, *Hurt*, or *In Transit Beautiful*.






Veteran politician Sushilkumar Shinde's career trajectory is unrivalled in Indian politics - from beginning life as a Dalit who worked as a ward

In this forthright memoir, he takes us through the highs and lows of his journey – from being 'discovered' by Sharad Pawar, to his first few elections, to becoming the chief minister of Maharashtra, and then union power and home minister during the Congress-led UPA's tumultuous second term.

Shinde's tenure as home minister saw the controversial trials and executions of Ajmal Kasab and Afzal Guru, the 2012 Delhi gangrape case and an investigation of 'Hindu terror' groups. He gives us a behindthe-scenes view of these significant events, the working relationships between the PM and his ministers, and the true extent of then Congress President Sonia Gandhi's influence during the UPA era. As the ultimate 'insider', he also weighs in on the Congress post-20!4.

SUSHILKUMAR SHINDE is a veteran politician who served as the Minister of Home Affairs (2012-14) and Minister of Power (2006-12) and the Leader of the House in Lok Sabha. He served as the Chief Minister of Maharashtra from 2003 to 2004.




## THE OTHER MOHAN IN BRITAIN'S INDIAN OCEAN EMPIRE

A Personal Journey into History

On a quest to understand why her great-grandfather, Mohanlal, set sail for South Africa from pre-Independent India, Amrita Shah's wonderfully



engaging book sets on record for the first time a sweeping social and business history of the Indian diaspora in the Indian ocean, drawing out an incredible story spanning centuries of migrations and peopled by slaves, political prisoners, sex workers, lascars, smugglers, indentured workers, traders and interpreters.

Drawing on an extensive range of sources interwoven with her own first-hand research in India, South Africa, Mauritius and Britain, Shah covers a wide gamut, including in its sweep, the Indian Ocean, the medieval port of Surat where Europeans set up their earliest trading companies in India, the evolution of colonial Bombay and Indian migrant communities in the Indian Ocean littoral.

By foregrounding the story of her greatgrandfather and of the opportunistic drive that led thousands of Indians to seek their fortunes across an ocean, Shah also offers a supplementary history to explain many aspects of India's present.

AMRITA SHAH is a former editor of *Elle* and *Debonair*, a contributing editor with the *Indian Express* and has worked for the US-based Time-Life News Service. She is the author of the award-winning *Ahmedabad: A City in the World* (2015), *Vikram Sarabhai: A Life* (2007) and *Telly-Guillotined: How Television Changed India* (2019).







The issue of 'insiders' and 'outsiders' in Northeast India has caused severe friction in the region for decades. In recent years, this issue has

spilled over outside the region, in the form of the National Register of Citizens and the Citizenship Amendment Act. But I am One of You is an anthology where writers from across Northeast India write on the theme of being an insider or an outsider in the region, and perhaps in India as well.

This anthology attempts to address these and similar issues by bringing in a variety of voices from different sides of divides because in the region, the micro-history of each community and group is distinctive, and every state has its own multiplicity of stories.





Since the economic reforms of the 1990s, India's economy has grown rapidly. To sustain growth requires a well-developed legal infrastructure



for conducting business. But India's legal infrastructure is in urgent need of reform, plagued by problems.

In this incisive volume, renowned economists Tirthankar Roy and Anand V. Swamy begin by tracing the origins of the current Indian legal system. They show how India inherited an elaborate legal system from the British colonial administration, even as they examine the contents and historical antecedents of these laws, including how they have stifled economic development.

Weaving the story of India's heralded economic transformation with its social and political history, they show how inadequate legal infrastructure has been a key impediment to the country's economic growth during the last century. 



During her long career, Sudipta did field work in remote areas around the world and had several interesting encounters with people and animals. She joined the first women's mountaineering expedition to Ronti peak in the Himalayas in 1967 and was the only surviving summiteer of an 'all women' expedition to Mount Lalana – a peak she was the first to climb and name.

In this book, she narrates her adventures from the Himalayas, Scotland and Scandinavia to the Arctic and the Antarctic. She also provides a rare glimpse into what it meant to choose a career in science as a woman half a century ago.

SUDIPTA SENGUPTA is a Professor of Geology. In her distinguished career, she has done post-doctoral research work at Imperial College, London, the Institute of Geology of Uppsala University, and has worked at the Geological Survey of India and taught at Jadavpur University. Being a day scholar in a boarding school in Darjeeling, Pema misses all the


