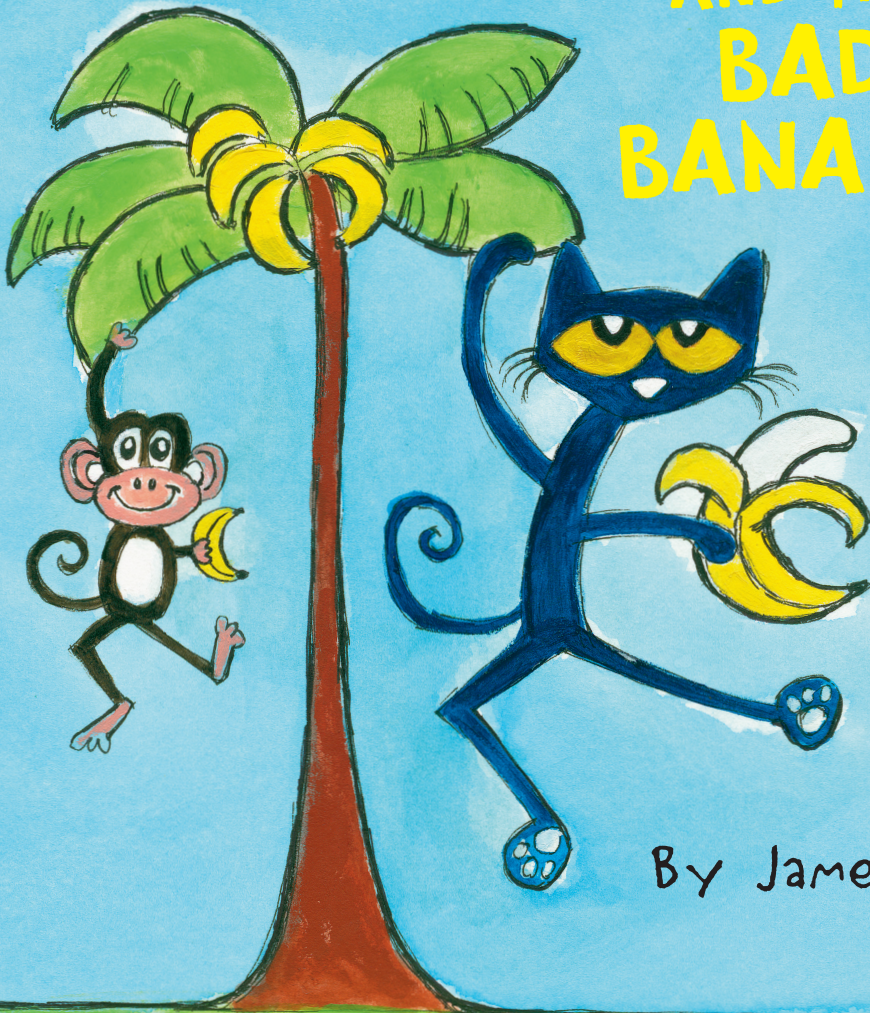

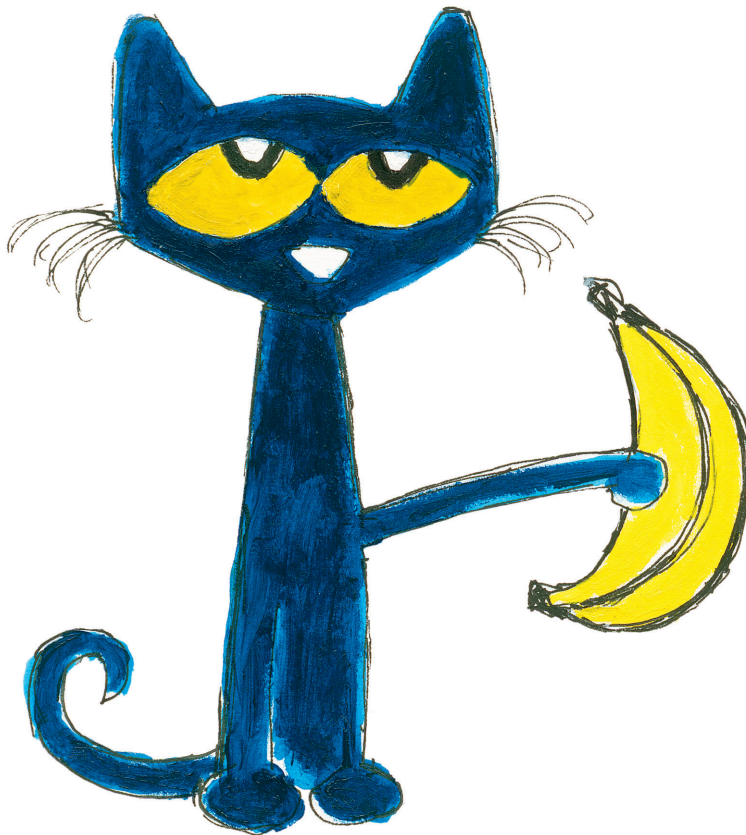

Pete tells his mom.



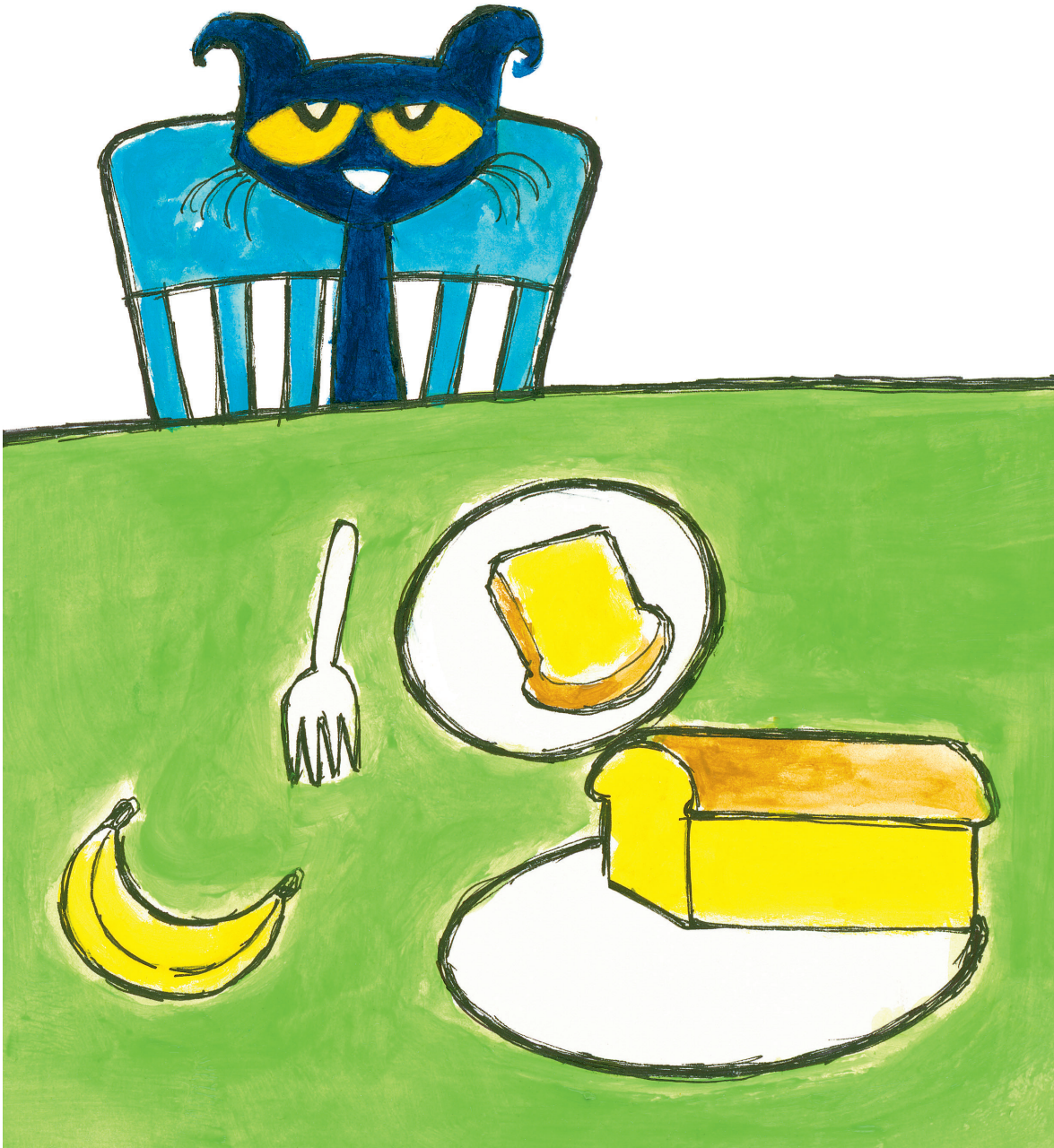
Pete's mom tries to help.

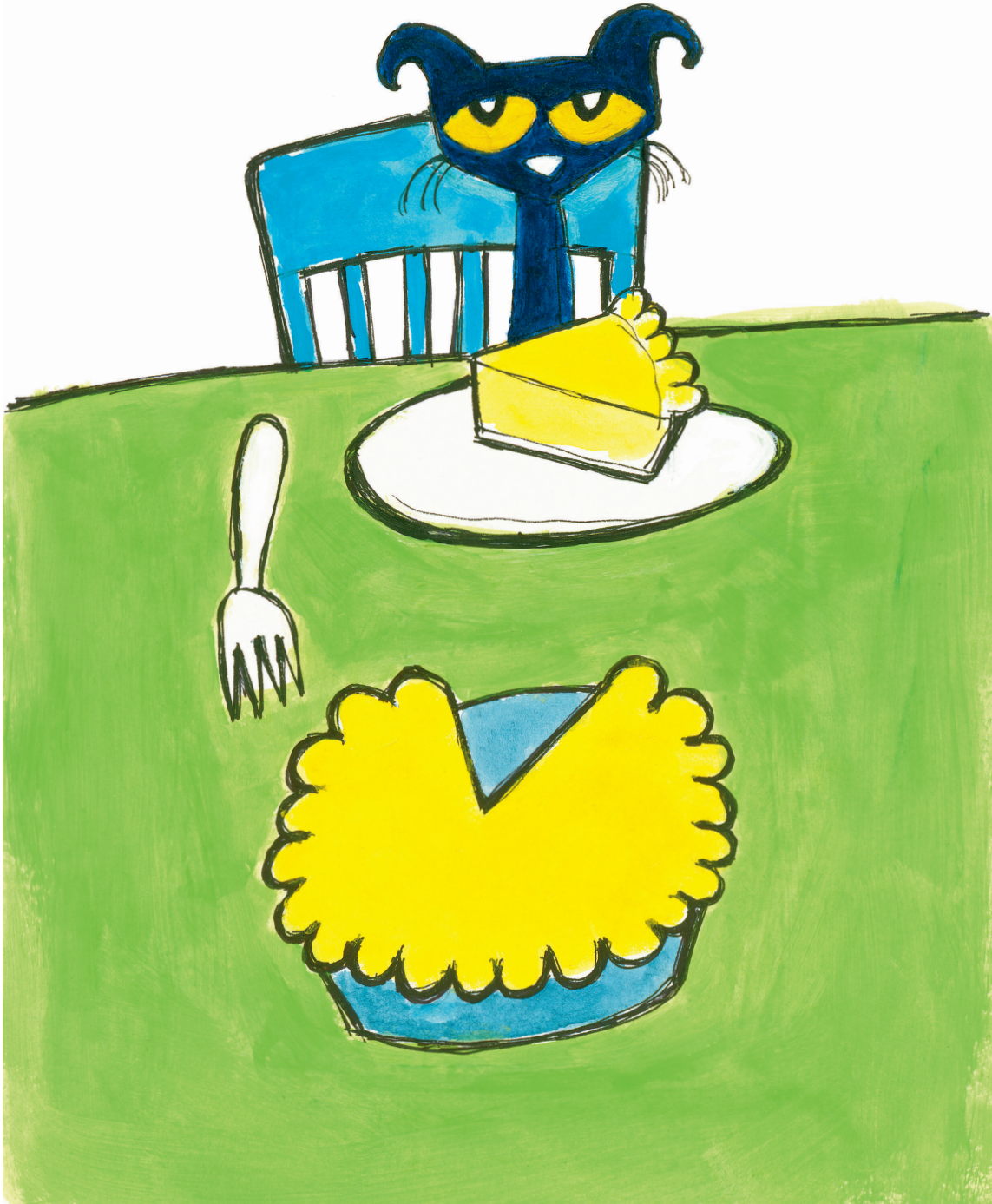
